Divisions Available

The following divisions are offered to archers. The final divisions will be determined on the day and will be dependent on having at least two archers competing in the division.

Division	Equipment Allowed
Compound Open	Compound bow, release aid, Movable sights/ Scope, any stabiliser configuration
Compound Bowhunter	Compound bow, release aid, max 5 fixed pins and short stabiliser (max 12")
Compound Sighted	Compound bow, fingers, any sights and short stabiliser (max 12")
Compound Barebow	Compound bow, fingers, no sights, no stabiliser
Recurve Bowhunter	Recurve bow, no sights and short stabiliser (max 12")
Recurve Sighted	Recurve bow, fingers, any sights, any stabiliser configuration
Recurve Barebow	Recurve bow, fingers, no sights, no stabiliser
Longbow	Longbow, any wooden arrows, any shooting style (med or 3 under)
Youth Compound Open	Compound bow, release aid, Movable sights/ Scope, any stabiliser configuration
Youth Compound Bowhunter	Compound bow, release aid, max 5 fixed pins and short stabiliser (max 12")
Youth Compound Sighted	Compound bow, fingers, any sights and short stabiliser (max 12")
Youth Compound Barebow	Compound bow, fingers, no sights, no stabiliser
Youth Recurve Bowhunter	Recurve bow, and any sights stabiliser configuration
Youth Recurve Sighted	Recurve bow, fingers, no sights and short stabiliser (max 12")
Youth Recurve Barebow	Recurve bow, fingers, no sights, no stabiliser
Youth Longbow	Longbow, wooden arrows, any shooting style (med or 3 under)
Cub Compound	Compound bow with any release aid, any sights, any stabiliser
Cub Recurve	Recurve bow with any sights stabiliser configuration
Future Bowhunters	Compound, Recurve or Long bow, and any sights stabiliser configuration
Veteran	Any bow, any equipment
Novice Adults	Any equipment. For those with low levels of experience who are not yet confident. Request to compete in this category needs to be supported by your Club President

Notes:

- Veterans – aged over 55 years old
- Youth - aged between 13 and 17 years old
- Cub - aged between 8 and 12 years old
- Future Bowhunter - under 8 years old
