All clubs are invited to send juniors to this fun tournament. Make up a team of four: any age group, ability, and bow type.

We have two events: target and field. All competitors will be split into two groups to tackle the field and target at different times. All individual results will be tallied and the team with the highest points wins!

Divisions:

U20 Recurve
U14 Recurve
U20 Compound
U14 Compound

Target distances:

- U20: 45m, 35m
- U14: 25m, 18m

Field distances

- U20: 35m max
- U14: 20m max



Each team entered will need:

- A name
- A Flag or banner
- A team captain
- A team uniform

Prizes are given for the top three teams, best flag, best uniform and other spot prizes are given on the day!

Junior Team Tournament: How it Works

Composition of Teams:

Teams can be made up of any four archers and contain a mix of the divisions (U14 Recurve, U14 Compound, U20 Recurve, U20 Compound). The scoring for the events is the highest scorer in a division gets 1000 points, with the next place-getters pro-rated from there. A team with mixed ages and bow types has a higher probability of a better overall team score.

Team Name, Flag, Uniform:

Teams are encouraged to organise a fun team name, bring a banner for them (and their supporters) to wave on the day, and organise their own uniform. Last year we had a team of Zombies, some Men in Black and some Indians. Get creative! There are prizes for best uniform and best flag.

Target Event:

The target will be held in two sections. The U20s will shoot first in the morning. The U14s will shoot second in the afternoon.

U20s will shoot 36 arrows at 45m and then 36 arrows at 35m. The target face will be 122cm and the scoring is 10-zone scoring (inner ten scores an X).

U14s will shoot 36 arrows at 25m and 36 arrows at 18m. The target face will be 122cm and the scoring is 10-zone scoring (inner ten scores an X).

Remember that X's score 10 points when you are doing the scoring.

Field Event:

The field will be held in two sections. The U14s will shoot first in the morning. The U20s will shoot second in the afternoon.

There will be 6 field targets set up around the Auckland Archery Club area. Each group will be divided into 6 and they will rotate around the targets twice (shooting 12 targets in total). They will be both uphill and downhill and a variety of distances.

The maximum distance for U20 will be 35m.

The maximum distance for U14 will be 20m.

Scoring will be on a World Archery field face, which has six zones. The inner bullseye scores a 6, with the rest of the scoring zones 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

There will be one 2-D target with heart-zone scoring of 11, 10, 8, 5 (11 for the centre, 10 for the heart, 8 for the lungs and 5 for a body shot).

Zombie Shoot:

At lunchtime all competitors are encouraged to try our Zombie shoot! It's a team event – one arrow per team member, and there is a prize for highest scoring team.

There will also be a mini-clout "Shooting the Fish in the barrel" where you get to use our mini Cartel Compound and try to nail the fish. One arrow, one shot – the fish was completely missed last year so now's your chance!
