Divisions

Recurve (Individuals & Teams) Compound (Individuals & Teams) Other than these two categories, there shall be no age or gender classification. All archers must belong to an Auckland Secondary School.

Rounds

Qualification Round:

- 30 arrows @ 25m, 80cm targets (compounds may use 10-5 spots)
- One 6-arrow sighting end
- All ends consist of 6 arrows

Individual Matchplay: All divisions at 25m, knock-out format, 12-arrow matches, 6-arrow ends *Team Matchplay*: All divisions at 25m, knock-out format

Recurve: 24-arrow matches (2 ends of 3 arrows per archer)

Compound: 12-arrow matches (2 ends of 3 arrows per archer)

Teams

For the Team Matchplay, a Team consists of pre-selected archers from one secondary school (four for recurve or two for compound), with an appointed captain and a manager. If space becomes limited, a cap may be placed on the number of entries from each school.

Attire

School sports uniform/tracksuit. Closed in shoes.

Equipment

Standard World Archery rules apply.

Food

A sausage sizzle will be running through the event, selling sausages and drinks. As the matches will be running alternatively through lunch time, we recommend that all archers bring lunch, or take advantage of the BBQ, as there may not be sufficient time to buy lunch elsewhere.

Safety

As we are situated in a busy public park, strict safety procedures must be adhered to. This information is included in the Shooting Protocol on the College Sport website.
